

La Crosse HOG has adopted a 'Zero Tolerance' policy for drivers on all Chapter group rides. This policy was implemented June 4, 2005, and reads:

The La Crosse Area Chapter HOG is a 'zero tolerance' HOG Chapter for all Chapter sponsored rides. By choosing to participate in a Chapter sponsored ride, all drivers of all motorcycles agree they shall come to an event without having consumed any intoxicating beverage prior to participation on Chapter sponsored rides and agree to not consume intoxicating beverages while participating on Chapter sponsored rides. Once the 'kickstand goes down' and the ride has terminated, Chapter policy is no longer in effect. Should a rider choose to consume intoxicating beverages while on a Chapter ride, it is the responsibility of the rider to remove himself or herself from the ride. Failing that, it is the responsibility of the ride leader to ask the rider to remove himself or herself from the ride. Failing that, the ride leader will cancel the remainder of the ride.
